Wheelchair-Accessible Entrances for the Capitol Complex

The AOTA staff has compiled the following accessibility information for your use on Capitol Hill Day.

House of Representatives Office Buildings

- Rayburn House Office Building: East side of the building on S. Capital St.
- Longworth House Office Building: West side of the building on S. Capital St.
- Cannon House Office Building: West side of the building on N.J. Ave.

Senate Office Buildings

- Hart Senate Office Building: East side of the building on 2nd St. N.E.
- Dirksen Senate Office Building: There are two wheelchair-accessible entrances: One is at the south side of the building on Constitution Ave; the other is on the north side of the building on C St.
- Russell Senate Office Building: There are no wheelchair-accessible entrances.
 However, there are fully accessible tunnels that connect all buildings in the Capitol complex.
