- Provide light refreshments (up to \$500 allowance provided).
- Help recruit participants from your local community.

What Will AOTA Do?

- Publicize workshops through the AOTA Web site and publications (adequate notification required).
- Provide online registration (AOTA Members: \$225, nonmembers: \$359).
- Offer two (2) complementary workshop registrations for the host facility.
- Provide teaching materials, participant handbooks, and certificates.
- Provide up to \$500 allowance for refreshments.
- Provide instructor honorariums.
