



ACOTE's Disclosure Statement regarding Probationary Accreditation Action:

The occupational therapy program at **York College, The City University of New York**, Jamaica, New York, was placed on Probationary Accreditation effective August 7, 2010, for nearing the end of the mandated time period for returning the program to compliance with [2006 OT Master's-Level Standard A.5.4](#) (certification exam pass rates).

At its April 2011 meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Report submitted by the occupational therapy program and determined that the program remained in noncompliance with 2006 OT Master's-Level Standard A.5.4. ACOTE granted the program a 1-year extension of the period for compliance with OT Master's-Level Standard A.5.4 due to an upward trend in certification exam pass rates.

At its August and December 2011 meetings, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Reports submitted by the occupational therapy program and determined that the program remains in noncompliance with 2006 OT Master's-Level Standard A.5.4 (certification exam pass rates). The program's status remains Probationary Accreditation due to continued concerns about the program's ability to comply with the 70% pass rate requirement within the allowable time period. The program has been requested to submit a Progress Report to return the program to full compliance with the Standard within the mandated time period for correction.

York College reviewed the above statement and had the opportunity to add comment prior to public posting.
