

What is RSS?

Do you check your favorite Web site everyday to see if it's been updated? Look no more. Keep track of your favorite websites in one location using RSS. When a website updates, you see a description of the change and a link. It's that simple. In fact, RSS means "Really Simple Syndication". Reuters has a quick [RSS primer](#), and c|net also provides a [good intro](#).

How do I set it up?

- 1) Choose an RSS reader (we provide a starter list below).
- 2) Subscribe to one or all of our feeds by copy and pasting this link into your reader's "add feed" or "subscribe" form:
