Driving Assessment and Training Techniques:

Addressing the Needs of Students with Cognitive and Social Limitations Behind the Wheel

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1) Visual Search CD

Increase visual search skills by training driver to quickly identify critical information while ignoring unnecessary stimuli. Improve driver's attention and ability to quickly process critical information.

This tool provides 65 road scenes of increasing complexity while introducing and reinforcing a systematic method to scan for critical information. Each scene is presented with and without critical information highlighted to allow assessment and training. The CD includes a printable one-page overview of how to scan for critical information, allowing the therapist to provide the client with a reinforcing take-home activity.

The tool is designed for both experienced and inexperienced drivers with Asperger syndrome, autism, attention deficit disorder, nonverbal learning disability, stroke, traumatic brain injury, or post traumatic stress disorder.

2) Critical Information Flip Chart

Passenger activity designed for non-drivers with verbal skills limitations. Enables the therapist to assess the visual search skills required for driving.

The passenger can point to specific items representing the stimulus that you have asked him or her to search for as you drive. The flip chart allows you to add one stimulus at a time, for a total of six. The flip chart is designed so that the stimulus order can be rearranged for a specific driving route. Stimuli include constant items such as side streets, and suddenly changing items such as brake lights and traffic lights.
