Final ACOTE® Accreditation Actions

Completion of the AOTA Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE®) due process procedures has resulted in the following April 2013 accreditation actions becoming final:

<u>Final ACOTE decision subsequent to a review of a Progress Report:</u>
 University of Puerto Rico at Humacao (OTA), Humacao, Puerto Rico—Accreditation Withdrawn-Involuntary, effective April 28, 2013 (Disclosure Statement)

Accreditation Withdrawn-Involuntary: Accreditation may be involuntarily withdrawn from a program with Probationary Accreditation if the accreditation review process confirms that the program has not come into substantial compliance with the Standards within the allowable time period. The sponsoring institution may apply for accreditation as a new applicant whenever the program is believed to be in compliance with the Standards and with the administrative requirements for maintaining accreditation. The program is expected to assist any students who have not yet completed their degrees to find reasonable opportunities to complete their education.

• <u>Final ACOTE decision subsequent to a review of a Candidacy Application (Step 1 of the Initial Accreditation Process)</u>:

Missouri College (OTA), Brentwood, Missouri—Candidacy Status Denied (<u>Disclosure Statement</u>)

<u>Candidacy Status Denied</u>: The proposed program either does not meet the requirements for Candidacy Status, or the application does not indicate the program's potential to achieve compliance with the Standards. Programs denied Candidacy Status are not able to admit students and are not eligible to proceed to the Initial Review step of the initial accreditation process; however, the program may reapply for Candidacy Status.
