Vision 2025 Strategic Plan Update

AOTA Vision 2025:

Vision 2025: As an inclusive profession, occupational therapy maximizes health, well-being, and quality of life for all people, populations, and communities through effective solutions that facilitate participation in everyday living.

Pillars:

- Effective
- Leaders
- Collaborative
- Accessible
- Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion



Transform:

- Current membership stands at around 50k (20%) with goal of 55k.
- Had 457 research papers submitted to Inspire--24 accepted courses, 277 posters.
- Competency Based Education Oversite Task Group appointed by the RA.
- AOTA recognizes 69 specialty Fellowship programs; 23 in candidacy/applicant.
- ACOTE New Standards (2023) go into effect July 31, 2025.
- AOTA now sponsors 34 Communities of Practice with over 2500 participants.
- 5 AOTA Practice Guidelines accepted into the ECRI Guidelines Trust.
- AOTA was accepted to NCCIH Coalition for Whole Person Health.
- Joined the National Academies of Science Engineering and Medicine TBI Forum.
- Approved Provider Program exceeding goals for activities and new providers.



Advocate:

- Total of 330 registrants for Hill Day on Sept. 20, 2024 with 32 states and DC.
- Well-attended and engaged office hours regarding US Dept. of Education.
- OT and Falls prevention was reintroduced in Congress.
- Medicare Advantage advocacy led to improved prior authorization changes.
- Medicare wins for OTA supervision requirements, reduced administrative burden, telehealth, reduced cuts, and partnerships for co-sponsorships on legislation.
- Collaborating with state associations on licensure and regulatory tracking.
- Received the 2025 AMA Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Educational Excellence Award!



Build:

- DEIJAB Team awarded \$250,000 grant by the Sandy Hoskins Legacy Fund to support the RISE Program and AOTA Diverse Leaders Program Scholars.
- The DEIJAB Team organized 2 listening sessions revolving around Executive Orders and potential changes with 1200+ member registrants.
- An AJOT Special Edition on DEIJAB was recently released.
- Ethics Commission is updating the Code of Ethics—esp. Professional Standards.
- Expanded Partnerships for AOTA INSPIRE 2025, Institute for Future Scientists in OT, the Lands Banks Memorial Scholarship Fund, and AOTF 60th Anniversary.
- The 2025 OT Month Campaign launched in January with the theme:
 - "Inspiring Hope, Changing Lives."
- Vision 2030 Campaign official launch on Wednesday, April 2nd at 2 pm ET.
